PAKISTAN NAVY HANDS OVER 8 IRANIAN FISHERMEN TO THE CONSULATE GENERAL OF IRAN

<u>Karachi, 09 May 24:</u> Pakistan Navy handed over 8 Iranian Fishermen to the Consulate General of brotherly neighbour Islamic Republic of Iran on pure humanitarian grounds. These fishermen were earlier rescued by Pakistan Navy War Ship from sea after uncontrollable fire incident occurred on their boat.

In response to the distress call from Iranian fishing boat under massive fire, PNS YARMOOK while operating in vicinity, immediately dashed to handle the situation. Despite heavy fire on the vessel, PNS YARMOOK not only safely rescued all 8 crew members from the sea who had abandoned the boat but also controlled the fire onboard blazing vessel by using its own modern firefighting equipment.
