CHIEF OF NAVAL STAFF ADMIRAL NAVEED ASHRAF VISITED COMMAND AND STAFF COLLEGE QUETTA AND ADDRESSED THE COURSE MEMBERS.

While addressing the staff course participants, the Naval Chief gave an overview of the contemporary conflicts around the world and their implications on geo-political and maritime environment. He highlighted that warfare is under perpetual transformation from unmanned systems to AI-powered combat, Gray-Hybrid conflict and Cyber Warfare. Therefore, Synergetic Tri-Service application is of utmost importance for operational success.

Admiral Naveed Ashraf said that national prosperity and security are closely linked to the development of the maritime sector, and a strong Navy is imperative to secure maritime interests both in peace and war. He highlighted that given the complexities of evolving threats; Pakistan Navy will continue to pursue indigenous capability development along with westward naval expansion. Chief of the Naval Staff shared Pakistan Navy vision to be a force-of-choice for Pakistan's national security and a force that will make a difference and ensure resolute defence of maritime frontiers.

Admiral Naveed also provided an overview of the recent and future inductions of state-of-the-art naval platforms and acquisition of modern indigenous technology. He highlighted PN initiative of Pakistan Maritime Science and Technology Park (PMSTP) which will provide necessary technical assistance and involve local industry in the development of products for maritime sector in general, and Pakistan Navy in particular.
