PAKISTAN NAVY ESTABLISHES FREE EYE CAMPS AT GHARO & GADDANI

Islamabad, 16 Dec 19: With an aim to facilitate and educate the local populace about eye related diseases, Pakistan Navy established Free Eye Camps at Gharo in Sindh & Gaddani in Balochistan. These Eye Camps were established in collaboration with Haji Razzak Janoo Memorial Trust and Eye Sight Trust.

Teams comprising qualified Eye Specialists along with related paramedical staff were deputed at the eye camps. The teams provided free consultation to visiting patients from Gharo in Sindh and Gaddani in Balochistan.
