Karachi, 19 May 24: Pakistan Navy arranged an informative visit of Pakistan Navy Warship for teachers and students from local school of Gwadar. Primary objective to organize this visit was to enlighten local students about Maritime role, organizational structure, and defence capabilities of Pakistan Navy.
